
## LATERAL BUOYS



| <b>FAIRWAY</b><br>This buoy marks safe water at landfalls, channel entrances or channel centres.<br>While you may pass it on either side, keep it on the port (left) side when going in<br>either direction. | WHITE<br>UIGHT<br>STALLSING |

| <b>ISOLATED DANGER</b><br>This buoy marks an isolated danger, such as a small shoal or a wreck that has<br>navigable water all around it. Consult the chart to learn the size, depth, etc. of<br>the danger. |                             |

## STANDARD DAYBEACONS

| <b>Port Hand</b><br>When going upstream, keep a port hand<br>daybeacon on your port (left) side. | <b>Starboard Hand</b><br>When going upstream, keep a starboard<br>hand on your starboard (right) side. | Junction (Preferred channel to right)<br>This daybeacon marks a point where<br>the channel divides and you may pass<br>it on either side. If you want to take<br>the channel to your right, keep this<br>daybeacon on your port (left) side. | Junction (Preferred channel to left)<br>This daybeacon marks a point where the<br>channel divides and you may pass it on<br>either side. If you want to take the channel<br>to your left, keep this daybeacon on your<br>starboard (right) side. |
